No Room at the Inn

The Lord is blessing this ministry! We are weekly receiving phone calls, "Please, can you take a baby", "We are desperate, this baby needs a place to go", " Can you take my child, I do not know where else to go"....this from both social workers and mothers It is heart breaking that we have to turn away these little ones. At present we are bursting at the seams and there is "no more room at the inn" - we do not even have a barn or a manger!

There is a baby sleeping in a dresser drawer, a soft side infant carrier, on a matt on the floor, a camp cot in the lounge, and one in our bedroom.

We now not only have abandoned, abused, and neglected babies; but those whose mothers are in a women's shelter and are psychologically unfit or are finding jobs to get back on their feet to raise their children. The latter are on a short term (6-8 month) basis where hopefully the mother has been able to support herself and be able to take her child back. A few are on a foster care situation and the rest we need to get into the adoption process to forever homes.

The time has come to look for a larger place...so far a look on the internet is all we have had time for. There are a number of homes with 5 or so bedrooms, which is about as large as we want, to be able to keep a family home atmosphere. Many of these also have a second cottage or house on the property to hopefully house another couple to come alongside and help. The cost

of these places are higher than what we are presently in, but would meet the needs without a lot of work. Somewhere around \$200.000 to \$250,00 to purchase.

Notice that our building fund is off the ground. Seeing the Lord provide as He has, we know that He will also provide the funding for a larger place. Please be in prayer as to what the Lord would have you do to help. We are trusting for the Lord to provide a place quickly and efficiently as we do not have much time to go out looking.

We now have 15 babies/ children ages 4 months to 4 years.

Our 10 days solo for Christmas went much better than we had anticipated! These were the days we were on our own as our staff had the week off

Christmas Eve was spent with wonderful friends willing to put up with all of us. We enjoyed home made pizza and a traditional dish that Marie's family has had for years.

Christmas Day we decided to stay home and have a "quiet" day with the children. As most of them have never had a Christmas, they were quiet with anticipation as to what would come next. We sat them around the living room and let them open one gift at a time—they were so excited, even over the gifts that others received.

Ham dinner was on the schedule...but you know what they say about "best laid plans"....so we had peanut butter and jelly sandwiches for lunch and porridge For supper. The ham dinner was on hold until the next evening.



The Lord knows, we know, and now you know...it is becoming crucial to get the funds to purchase a larger home. Not only are we bursting at the seams as mentioned, but the house we are currently in is on the market. Jacob was a cheater, Peter had a temper, David had an affair, Noah got drunk, Jonah ran from God, Paul was a murderer, Gideon was insecure, Miriam was a gossiper, Martha was a worrier, Thomas was a doubter, Sarah was impatient, Elijah was depressed, Moses stuttered, Zaccheus was short, Abraham was old, and Lazarus was dead....
