The nights have been in the 30's F... remember, we do not have heat in our homes here.

In our last newsletter we mentioned that the house we are currently renting has been put on the market. Now it has sold and we have been given our 60 day notice. We need to be out by the end of July. We take this as another confirmation that the house we have signed an agreement on is the direction we are to go. So this letter comes with urgency that we must raise the funds to purchase this property as quickly as possible. Our goal is \$210,000.00 by the end of July.

Dear Friends and Family,

I just got back from visiting missionary friends in South Africa. Marv and Marie Bjorklund are from Alexandria, MN and have started an orphanage in that country, taking in, at last count, 15 children! Some of these kids' parents have died from AIDS and some have just been abandoned. As Marv commented, "It's amazing that only one of the children has HIV!" as AIDS is ravaging the country.

Two Americans in a 3 bedroom house with 15 children all under the age of 5. It was an amazing thing to see. And they get NO FUNDING from the South African government.

Now their problem. The house they are renting has sold. They have found the perfect house and have committed to trusting the Lord for the funds. Obviously they have spent all their own money caring for these children, and this is where we, as Christians, need to step in.

They need to raise – quickly – \$210,000 to buy the house: \$170,000 for the house and another \$30,000 for the renovations it will need. So I have broken it down this way: We need either 200 people to give \$1000 each or 2,000 people to give \$100 each to get this house. But <u>any amount will be greatly appreciated</u> as time is running out because the house will be put back on the market soon if Marv and Marie can't come up with the necessary funds.
